Reference is invited to Council's Advt. No. 28/2017 dated 25th November, 2017 regarding recruitment to the post of Research Officer (Pharmacology) in the Council.

2. In response to the advertisement, the Council received 74 applications till the closing date for receipt of applications. In addition, 02 applications were received after the closing date and the same have been summarily rejected.

3. The Council made a preliminary scrutiny of the applications received. The position is as under:-

5. Eligibility of the candidates with regard to educational qualifications, caste/community status etc. has been made based on the information / documents submitted by the candidates. In many cases it has been noted that complete information regarding educational qualification has not been provided in the application form and necessary documents like mark sheets, degree certificates etc. have not been enclosed and thus, candidature of such candidates is provisional. Candidates, in their own interest, are advised to ensure that they are eligible in all respect as on the last date of receipt of applications.


6. The written test will be held on **22nd July, 2018, (Sunday)** as per the following details:-

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING FOR WRITTEN TEST

1. The written test will comprise 150 (One hundred fifty) Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs). The candidate will be required to indicate the best possible option, out of the suggested options, in the given scenario.
 2. **The test will be of 2 (two) hours duration.**
 3. The language of questions will be English only.
 4. There will be penalty for wrong answers. Every wrong answer will carry a deduction of **one-fourth (1/4)** of the marks assigned to that question. If a question is left blank, i.e., no answer is marked, there will be no penalty for that question. However, if a candidate gives more than one answer, it will be treated as a wrong answer, even if one of the given answers happens to be correct, and there will be same penalty as for wrong answer of a question.
 5. The candidate must bring the following documents to secure entry to the Examination Hall failing which the candidate will not be permitted to appear for the test:
 - a. **Admit Card** issued by the Council;
 - b. **A copy of Photo bearing identity proof along with its original**, such as Voters Card, Driving License, Aadhar Card, PAN card, etc.;
 - c. **One recent passport size photograph** for affixing on the Attendance Sheet.
- No other article will be allowed.**
6. **The candidate must not carry his/her writing instruments.** Pen/ Pencil will be provided by the Council. Further, the candidate will not be provided any separate sheet for rough work.
 7. The candidate is requested to report at the Examination Centre 01 (one) hour before the prescribed time for the commencement of the Test. **No candidate shall be allowed to enter in the examination center after the prescribed reporting time on any ground whatsoever.**
 8. The candidate is responsible for the safe custody of the Admit Card. In the event of one's Admit-Card being used by any person during the written test / interview, the candidate is responsible for such impersonation and his / her candidature will be cancelled and he / she will be liable for such action as deemed fit.
 9. Seating Plan for the candidates will be prepared and displayed at the venue of the examination on the day of examination. The candidates are advised to check the exact location of their seats before proceeding to the examination halls / rooms.
 10. After entering the Examination Hall, the candidate must sign the Attendance Sheets, Admit Cards (both on office copy and candidate's copy) in the presence of the Invigilator on duty.



11. The candidate must attempt questions in accordance with the directions given on the Question paper.
12. The candidate shall neither copy from the papers of any other candidate, nor permit his / her own papers to be copied. No attempt should be made to obtain / provide any kind of unauthorized assistance. Examination proceedings may be recorded electronically.
13. On completion of the Written Test, the candidate shall remain seated and wait until Answer Sheet is collected and is allowed to go by the Invigilator. The candidate should not engage in conversation with any other candidate after the expiry of the allotted time.
14. No candidate shall be permitted to leave the Examination Hall till expiry of the allotted time.
15. The candidate must abide by the instructions on the cover of the Question Paper and also on the Answer Sheet and such further instructions as may be given by Supervisor / Invigilator of the Test. If the candidate fails to do so or indulges in disorderly behavior or improper conduct, he / she will render himself / herself liable to expulsion from the Test and / or such other punishment as the Council may deem fit to impose.
16. The candidate will furnish such necessary and correct information as may be required from him / her in the Examination Hall by the Invigilator / Supervisor / other persons so authorized.
17. During the process of examination/interview, if a candidate is (or has been) found guilty of: (i) using unfair means during the examination or (ii) impersonating or procuring impersonation by any person or (iii) misbehaving in the examination hall or (iv) obtaining support for his/her candidature by any unfair means, such a candidate may, in addition to rendering himself/herself liable to criminal prosecution, will also be liable to be disqualified from the examination for which he/she is a candidate.

HANDLING OF QUESTION PAPER AND ANSWER SHEET:

18. Immediately after the commencement of the Written Test the candidate should check that the Question Paper supplied to him / her does not have any unprinted or torn or missing pages. If so, he/she should bring it to the notice of the Invigilator and get it replaced.
19. The candidate should carefully read the instructions for marking the answers. Any deviation in marking the response may result in not awarding the marks to the response. Further, the candidate must not write his / her name or anything else except the specific item of information asked for in the Answer Sheet.
20. The candidate must take care to ensure that the Answer sheet is not folded, mutilated or torn during handling. There should not be extraneous marking(s) in the Answer Sheet.
21. The candidate should not tamper with or take away the Answer Sheet with him / her. He / she will be penalized for any attempt to do so.

GENERAL

22. The Council has issued Admit cards to the candidates who have been found provisionally eligible/ eligible subject to submission of documents. **The candidates, in their own interest, must ensure that they are eligible in all respects.** The candidate must also note that his / her admission to the Written Test and/or Interview is strictly **“Provisional”**. The mere fact that an Admit Card for the Written Test / invitation letter for Interview has been issued to him / her does not imply that the candidature has been finally accepted by the Council or that the entries made by the candidate in his / her application have been accepted by the Council as true and correct. The candidate must also note that if ineligibility is detected at any stage even after the Written Test / Interview or if the conditions prescribed in the Instructions given in the advertisement or any other additional information / documents called for at any stage are not compiled with, within the time specified therein, the candidature would be rejected.
23. Candidates must note that the category (SC/ST/OBC) / PH declared by them in the Attendance Sheet at the time of written test shall be final and the same would be taken into account for declaration of result of written test. Therefore, the candidates must ensure that they belong to the relevant category and have documents, in accordance with Government of India instructions, to justify their claims of belonging to the relevant category as on the closing date for receipt of applications.
24. At the time of interview, the candidates will be required to produce all the original documents for verification and No Objection certificate from the employer.
25. No TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for appearing in the Written Test and/or Interview.
26. Candidates may note that parents or accompanying person(s) will not be allowed to enter the Examination premises.
27. Mobile phone and other electronic gadgets are banned in the Examination Centre. In their own interest candidates are advised not to bring any electronic item/communication device like mobile phone, pager, laptop, wrist watch, etc. as the Council may not ensure their safe custody. Further, frisking of candidates may be carried out at the entry of examination premises.
28. The list of candidates shortlisted for interview will be uploaded on the website of the Council.

IMPORTANT NOTE :

You are advised to undertake the written test at your own risk i.e. after satisfying yourself that you fulfill the eligibility conditions as prescribed in the relevant advertisement and your admittance to the test is purely “Provisional”.
